GETTING TO THE EVENT:

- The conference is taking place at: Bristol City Football Club, Ashton Gate Stadium, Ashton Rd, Bristol BS3 2EJ, If you are travelling by car, leave the M5 at Junction 18 and travel along the Portway (A4) following signs for the Bristol Airport/Taunton (A38). Go over the swing bridge (Brunel Way), branch left into Winterstoke Road, and the ground is on your left
- Please note that if you are driving to the venue, Bristol has a 'clean air zone'. You must pay to drive within the zone if your vehicle does not meet the zone's emission standards, unless you have an exemption. - Car parking (complimentary) is available in the Winterstoke Road car park (BS3 2LQ) on a first come first serve basis. Delegates are required to input their car registration into the iPad, which will be brought to the room where our event is taking place, to ensure to receive complimentary parking. This can be done at any point during the day but must be completed before you exit the car park.
- The nearest train station is Parson Street Station which is a ten minute walk from Ashton Gate Stadium. Ashton Gate is two miles away from Bristol Temple Meads Station
- Please enter via VIP 2 entrance in the Lansdown Stand
