GETTING TO THE EVENT:

- The conference is taking place at: **Wembley Stadium, Olympic Way, Wembley, London, HA9 0WS**

- **By Tube:** From Wembley Park Station: As you approach the stadium along Olympic Way, remain at street level and walk under the pedestrian walkway. Straight in front of you is the Main Entrance
- **By Rail:** From Wembley Central, turn right out of the station. Turn left at the triangle, towards Wembley Stadium Station. Cross White Horse Bridge and turn left onto Wembley Park Boulevard. Follow the path in front of the London Designer Outlet, Wembley Arena is now on your left, turn right and walk under the pedestrian walkway. The Wembley Stadium Main Entrance is at the top of this road
- **By Car:** Pink Parking off South Way is the recommended car park. Blue Badge Holders should use Blue Parking, this car park leads directly to the stadium concourse For maps and parking charges see: <https://wembleypark.com/get-here/parking-wembley-park/>

IDENTIFICATION:

- Delegates **MUST** bring a physical copy of a **government issued photo I.D (Driver's Licence or Passport). Digital copies cannot be accepted**. This proof of identity is a mandatory requirement for access to Wembley Stadium
- All bags will be scanned via the x-ray machine on arrival
